Anderson (Andy) Riddle grew up in Albuquerque and graduated from Albuquerque Academy High School. He holds a degree in Biochemistry from Biola University in La Mirada California, graduating Magna Cum Laude. He has worked alongside Dr. Glenn Michael Dempsey as a Research Coordinator at Albuquerque Neuroscience Inc. since 2002, participating in over 60 clinical trials, including major depression, bi-polar, anxiety, insomnia, and fibromyalgia. Andy has helped conduct 12 Alzheimer's trials, including three ongoing and has extensive knowledge of the disease. He has earned the designation of Certified Clinical Research Coordinator (CCRS).
